Magazine as the third fastest growing private company in Indiana and was nationally ranked at No. 375 among the annual listing of the 500 fastest growing private companies in the U.S. Additionally, Adayana ranked 8th nationally among fastest growing companies in the Human Resources category. The 2009 Inc. 500 ranking is based on annual revenue growth from 2005-2008. Adayana's annual revenue has increased more than 677 percent since 2005.
